DELAY IN FILING AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR YEAR END 31ST DECEMBER, 2022

NPF Microfinance Bank Plc ("the Bank") wishes to notify the Nigerian Exchange Limited (NGX), its shareholders and the investing public that the Bank was unable to file her Audited Financial Statements for Year-ended 31st December, 2022 before the filing due date of 31st March 2023.

The delay was due to the constraints encountered with the banking application during the statutory audit exercise. This was principally in the areas of validation and agreeing of the spools of subsidiary ledgers with the Account headings on the Trial Balance. The impact was a considerable loss of audit time which kept the exercise behind scheduled audit time table and consequently affected the eventual submission of the Accounts for approval.

We wish to assure the entire public, our stakeholders, investors and regulators that the audited financial statements will be released as soon as we obtain the approval of our primary regulator, the Central Bank of Nigeria, which we expect to be not later than 30th April 2023.
